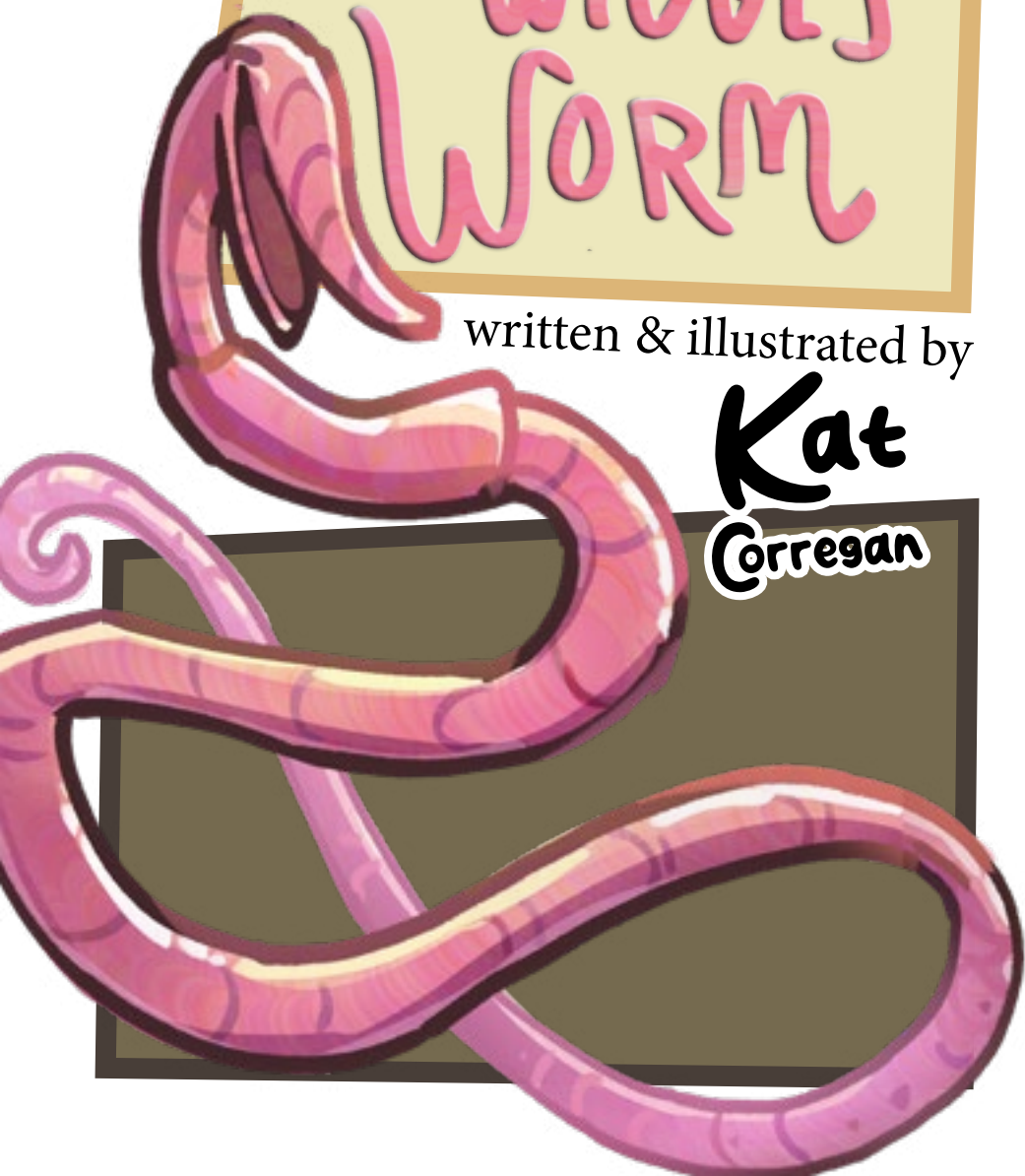

Squiggly-Wiggly Worm,



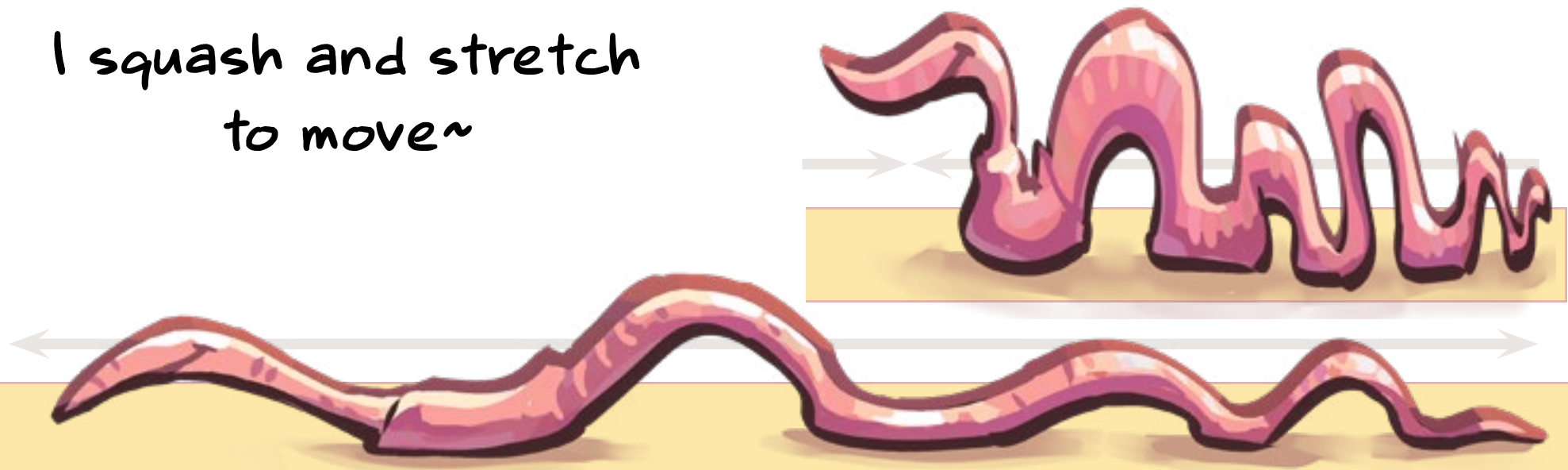
Here to help you learn!

favorite game

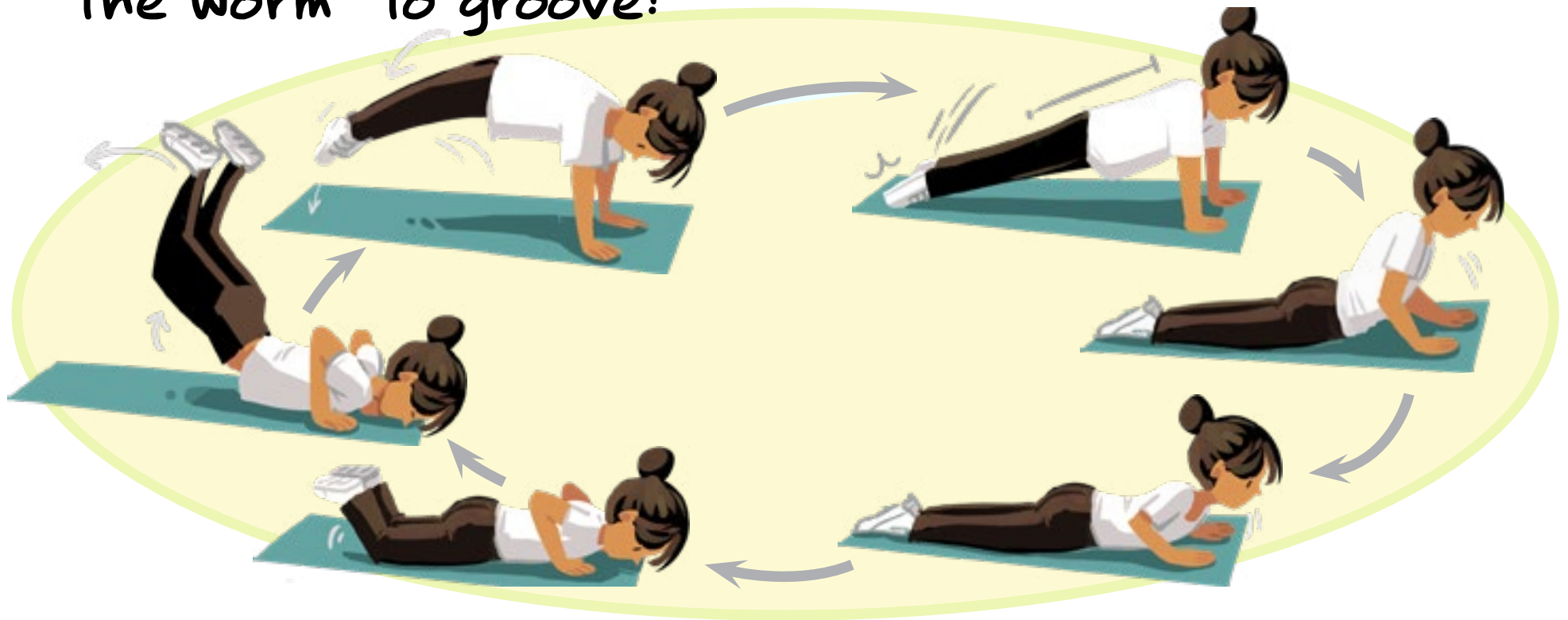


My front & back

to move~

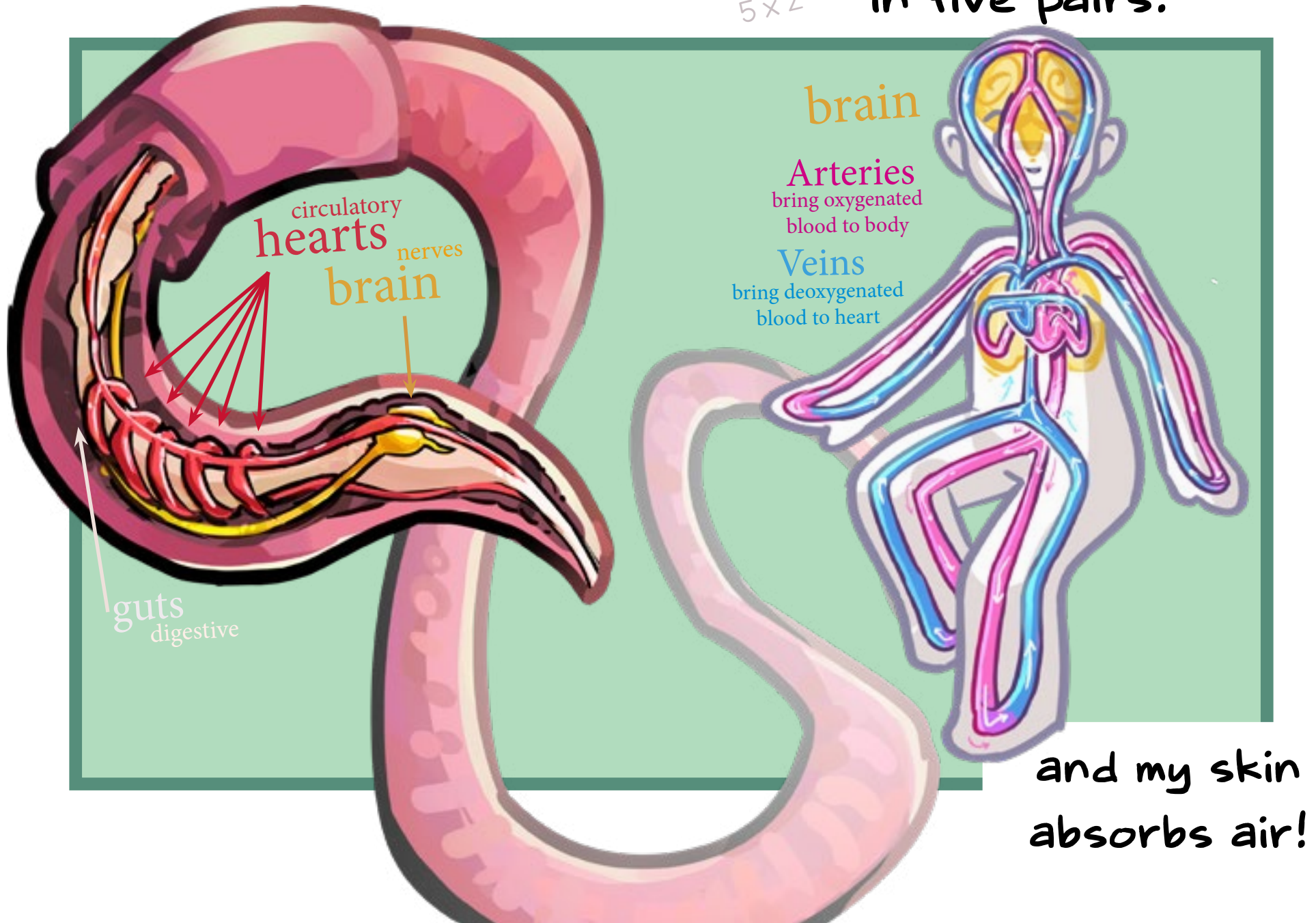


and you can do

 $5 \times 2 = 10$ in five pairs!

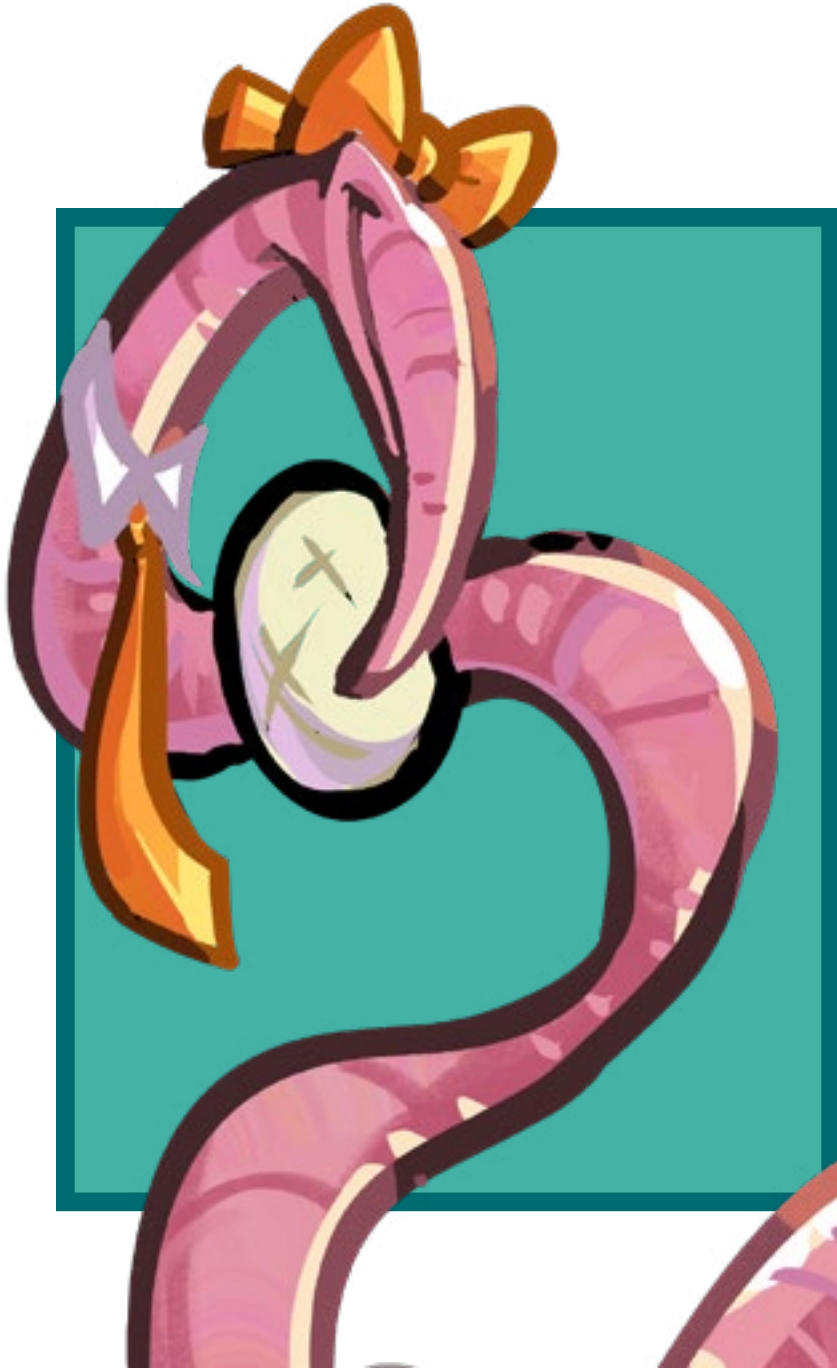


I have no bones,
or ears, or eyes...

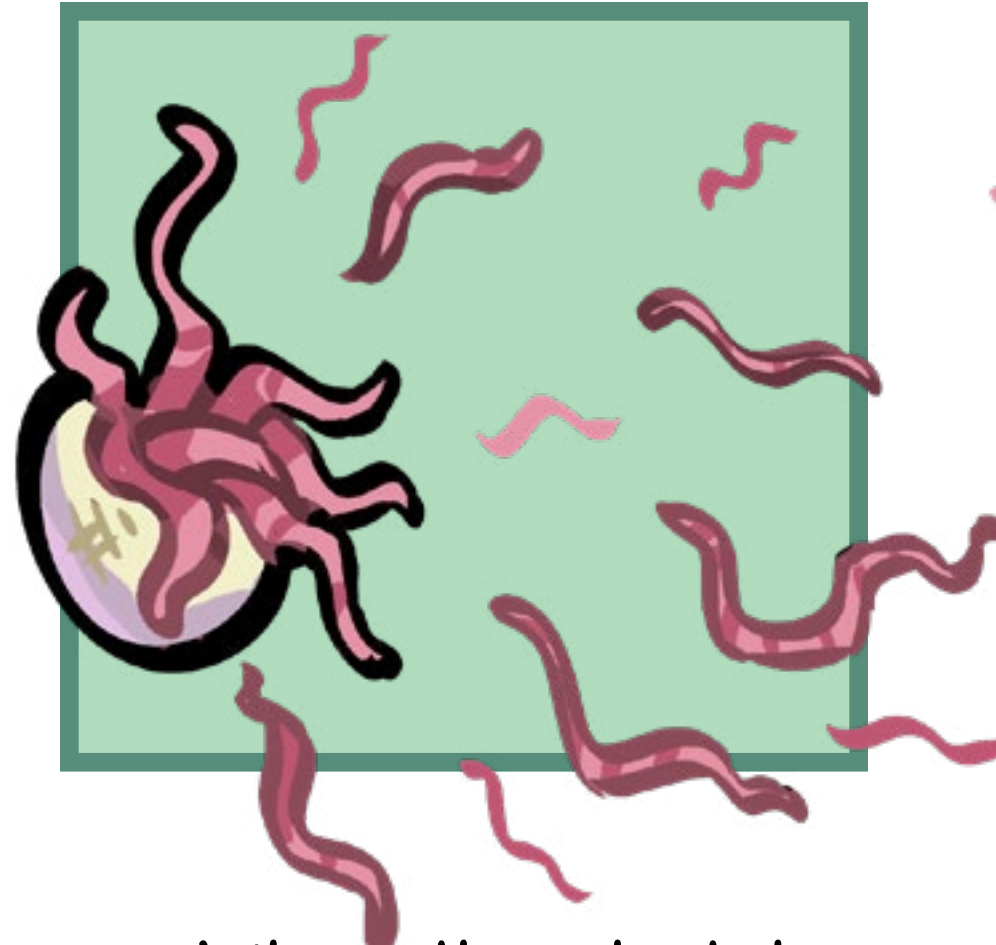


and here's another

How to Draw



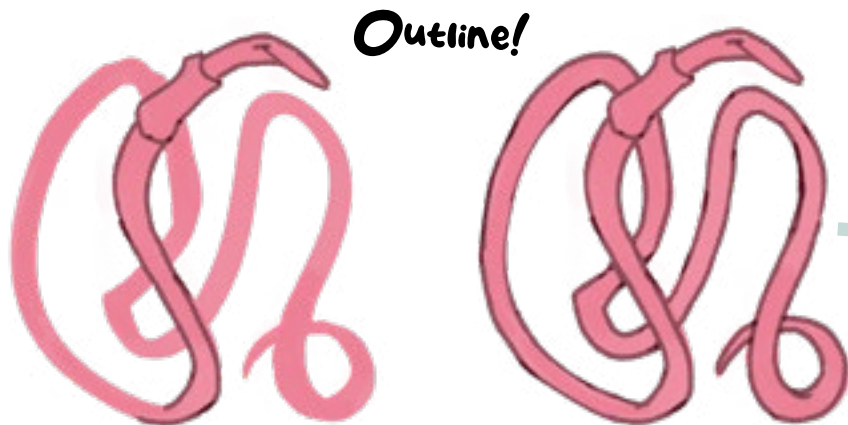
Start with a

add rings



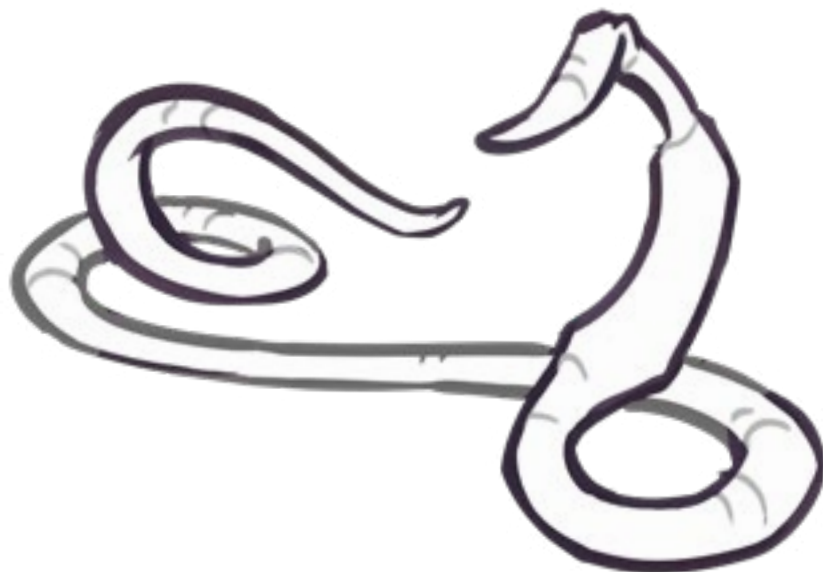
Add highlights~

angle consistent

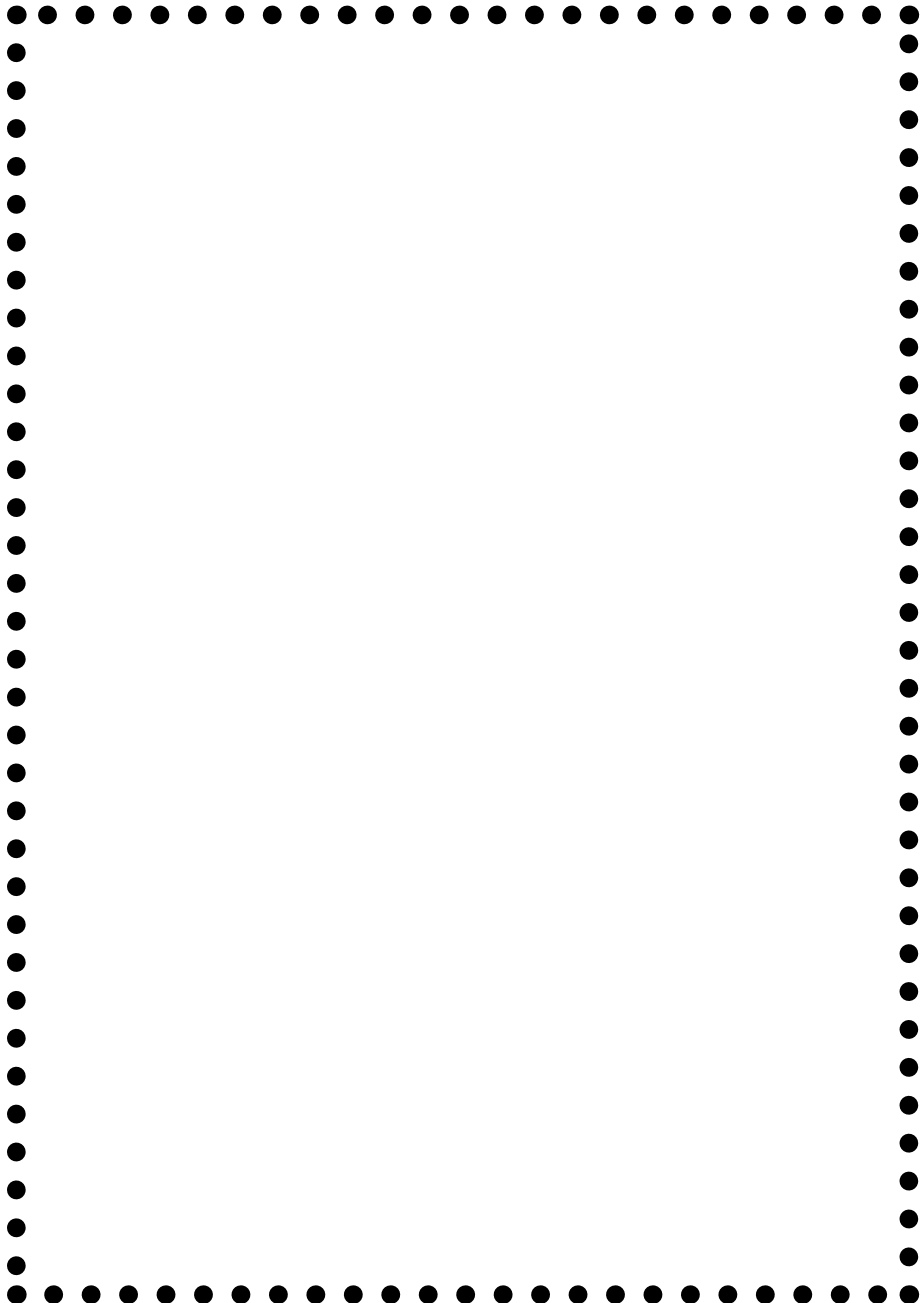
Play with
